No bids will be received or considered after the time of closing.

Clackamas County Facilities Management is soliciting bids to replace the building envelope (exterior shell) of the Clackamas County Emergency Operations Center located at 2200 Kaen Road, Oregon City, Oregon. All construction for the entire project is to be completed by December 31, 2016. The engineer's estimate is approximately \$300,000.

There will be a **mandatory** on-site walk-through on Tuesday June 7, 2016 at 9:00 AM. Only Bidders attending and signing in at the walk-through will be allowed to bid on this project. This does not apply to subcontractors.

No prequalification is required for this project.

This **is** a public work contract subject to ORS 279C.800 to 279C.870 **or** if applicable, the federal prevailing rate of wage required under the Davis-Bacon Act (40 U.S.C. 3141 et seq.).

Bid packets will be available at Clackamas County Procurement, Clackamas County Public Services Building, 2051 Kaen Road, Oregon City, OR 97045, phone 503-742-5444. **Hours of operation are Monday through Thursday from 7 AM to 6 PM.** Sealed bids are to be sent to George Marlton – Procurement Division Director at the Kaen Road address. Bids will be opened in the Procurement Division, located on the fourth floor of the Public Services Building, at the designated time.

The Clackamas County Board of County Commissioners reserves the right to reject any and all bids not in compliance with all prescribed public bidding procedures and requirements, may reject for good cause any and all bids upon the finding that it is in the public interest to do so, and may waive any and all informalities.
