The new website redesign will help with today's fast-paced online and mobile environment. The website will incorporate an adaptive user interface that works well regardless of device and shall integrate existing back-end architecture. CCTCA is seeking a vendor that will play an integral role in the production of front-end user interface (UI) redesign of the current website as a hub of all our mobile and online digital efforts to promote travel in Oregon's Mt. Hood Territory.

Sealed proposals are to be sent to George Marlton – Procurement Division Director at the Kaen Road address. Proposals will be opened in the Procurement Division, located on the fourth floor of the Public Services Building, at the designated time.

Each proposal must contain a statement as to whether the vendor is a resident vendor, as defined in ORS 279A.120.

The Clackamas County Board of County Commissioners reserves the right to reject any and all proposals not in compliance with all prescribed public bidding procedures and requirements, and may reject for good cause any and all proposals upon the finding that it is in the public interest to do so and to waive any and all informalities in the public interest. In the award of the contract, the Board of County Commissioners will consider the element of time, will accept the proposal or proposals which in their estimation will best serve the interests of Clackamas County and will reserve the right to award the contract to the contractor whose proposal shall be best for the public good.
