What is a CPO???

A CPO is short for Community Planning Organization. Many years ago, Oregon passed a law for people who lived in the unincorporated areas of the state and needed representation to their County government regarding land-use issues. This includes zone changes, changes in commercial, industrial, and multi-family buildings – for both new and remodeling projects.

S.U.N. CPO represents all unincorporated area residents from I-205 on the west, the bluff above 212/224 on the south, SE 142 on the east, and Happy Valley's continually-changing boundary on the north.
