



2015 Drug Convictions – 53 cases

Clackamas County: AA and Hispanic

Summary: This study looks at the 2015 drug convictions in Clackamas County that involved African Americans and Hispanic offenders. The purpose of this report is to look at where these offenders reside and what prompted initial contact with law enforcement. Initial offender data was provided by the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission and staff reviewed individual case files to obtain individual details.




Where are they from (by County)




- 33.3% of African Americans convicted were from Multnomah County
- 42.9% of African Americans convicted were considered Transient without a residence
- Only 19.0% of African Americans convicted were actually from Clackamas County
 - 3 of the 4 African Americans from Clackamas County were arrested through the ITF
 - These 3 comprised all ITF arrests of African Americans in Clackamas County
 - The remaining 4th offender was approached by CCSO for trespassing on church property at night
- 51.6% of Hispanic convicted were residents of Clackamas County

Reason for Initial Law Enforcement Contact



- 41.9% of Hispanic offenders were initially stopped on a Traffic Related offense →
- 38.1% of African Americans were initially contacted on Shoplifting offenses
- 22.6% of Hispanic offenders were initially contacted due to a Citizen Report



How or why Defendant came into contact with Law Enforcement

Hispanic

ITF Cases

- CI controlled buy, search of home yields meth
- ITF, CI case
- ITF, CI case (Co-Δ with case above)

Traffic Related

- Driving stolen vehicle and drives then runs away when followed. Drops drugs in chase
- Stopped for driving without headlights. Search of vehicle yields meth
- DUII stop, admitted to smoking meth
- Δ approached after found passed out in vehicle on road with vehicle and lights on. Search yields meth
- Traffic stop, consented search of vehicle yields 30 pounds of meth and 1 pound heroin
- Traffic stop, search of vehicle yields 30 pounds of meth and 1 pound heroin (Co-Δ of case above)
- Traffic infractions, consented search of vehicle yields 7 pounds Meth. Co-Δ ran away and was caught
- Traffic stop for DUII. Search yields cocaine
- Traffic infraction. Search yields meth
- Expired license plate, DMV check shows susp. and immigration warrant. Search yields pipe and meth
- Δ sleeping in car on sidewalk. Search yields meth pipe
- Δ stopped for riding bike without light or reflector. Search yields knife, meth pipe, and bong
- Traffic stop. Search reveals meth pipe, meth, firearm, scale

Theft Related

- Caught shoplifting with a knife. Search yields meth
- Caught shoplifting. Search of vehicle yields meth and syringes
- Caught shoplifting. Search yields pipe and meth

Citizens' Reports

- Report of Δ having a med emergency and police learn Δ has warrant. Search yields meth
- Response to a 911 call regarding Δ using heroin. Search yields syringe and heroin
- Report of Δ selling drugs outside business. Search yields heroin
- Report of burglary. Search yields pipe and meth
- Respond to a report of crazy man. Δ has active warrant. Search yields meth

- Response to a domestic report. Search of home yields cocaine, marijuana
- Officers respond to a juvenile molestation case

Other

- Δ staggering around streets. LEO checked for welfare and search reveals meth and pipe
- Littering/illegally camping with active warrant. Search yields heroin and meth
- Warrant for Δ. During service of warrant search of home yields heroin
- Search warrant executed on D's house following controlled buys (CI case)
- Δ unconscious on bus and taken to Detox center. Search yields meth

African American

ITF Cases

- Drug search warrant at Motel 6 (ITF case with CI)
- ITF respond to overdose death, supplier identified. (CI case)
- CI controlled buy. Search of vehicle yields Meth, Oxycodone

Traffic Related

- Δ pulled over for speeding, passenger has active warrant and car smelled of MJ. Search yields heroin
- Car of Δ was being towed and Δ had meth in coin purse on key chain

Theft Related

- Caught shoplifting. Search yields meth pipe
- Caught shoplifting. Search yields meth pipe
- Report of Δ removing tags/markers off new clothes. Search yields meth
- Caught shoplifting. Search yields meth pipe
- Caught shoplifting. Search yields meth pipe
- Caught shoplifting. Search yields heroin
- Caught shoplifting. Search of backpack yields meth and pipe
- Caught shoplifting. Search yields heroin
- Caught shoplifting. Search yields meth pipe


Citizens' Reports

- Report of employee in poss. of meth. Search yields meth
- Report of Δ dumpster diving. Active warrants, search yields meth
- Δ asked to leave ministry, but doesn't. Arrested for Trespass. Search yields meth


Other

- Unable to show valid train fare, search yields meth pipe
- Approached Δ and friend outside Church, DMV check shows felony warrant. Search yields meth
- Δ was occupant of house where someone else being arrested. Δ had loaded heroin syringe on ear
- Δ Stopped loitering outside Radio Shack, check shows Δ has PV warrant. Search yields meth






Average # of Convictions 3.1






