# The Workforce Investment Council of Clackamas County proposes Local Unified Plan for 2007-2009

The Workforce Investment Council of Clackamas County (WICCO) receives funds under the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 (WIA) to serve residents (youth, adults, and dislocated workers) and businesses in Clackamas County. For program years 2007 and 2009, WICCO anticipates receiving approximately \$3.3 million per year to provide individuals with workforce and training services and work with businesses to retain, upgrade or expand their workforce. WICCO's Local Unified Plan for 2007-2009 has been completed and is available for public review and comment from March 6, 2007 to close of business on April 4, 2007. Public feedback is an important part of making this plan an effective tool for meeting the needs of businesses and residents in Clackamas County.
