Proposal: A conditional use permit to establish a temporary and seasonal parking lot, on 13.2 acres in the FU-10 zone. The proposal includes a parking lot during the summer months near a take-out spot for people floating the Clackamas River from Barton to Carver. There will be paths from the river beach to the parking lot for people to use to walk their rafts, canoes or kayak from their cars to the river. The park will be open during the summer months through completion of the Carver Bridge replacement project for day use only. Access to the property is from Hwy 224
