Minutes: Ralph moved and Del seconded the motion to approve the March 1, 2011 minutes. They were unanimously approved.

Projects

- Hwy 43
The County hired consultant Ch2MHill to conduct a Bike Lanes Alternatives Analysis along Hwy 43 to look into potential remedies regarding bike facilities on Hwy 43.

- Clackamas Regional Center Pedestrian/Bicycle Connection Project. The March 2011 Site Visit Field notes were reviewed and the Committee had several additions. They included;
 - Under Sidewalk/Pedestrian Network Gaps

Curb cut into SE corner of Town Center parking lot is needed. Currently, a cyclist has to jump the curb. Locate cut where there is a worn path.

 - Under Bike Lane Gaps

Causey Road between 82nd Avenue and Fuller Road– need to narrow the center turn lane and paint and widen the bike lanes.

Need curb cut at I-205 path to Monterey Avenue. Next opportunity for a curb cut is about 100 yards away downhill. Without the curb cut the route is circuitous.

- 172nd/190th Corridor Project

The five alternative street designs have been narrowed down to three and are being evaluated at this time. The web site is www.172nd.com.

- Fading Bike Lane Paint/Bike Trains

Ralph said that the bike lane disappears north on Molalla by Wendy's. In addition, bike lane paint is fading in various places. Could reflectors be used where paint frequently wears off?

Ralph also talked about Bike Trains; bike trains encourage riders to bike in numbers to school.

The Committee indicated that they would like an update on the Sunrise Project and an update on engineering projects. Lori said that she would ask that someone from Engineering come to the next meeting to give a summary on engineering projects.
