I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Rob Smoot at 6:00 pm.

IV. BUSINESS

1. BORING STATION UPDATE

Mike gave an update on Boring Station project. Met with Harper Houf, the consultant working on construction designs. Harper Houf provided a modified concept plan and also met with Boring CPO and Friends of Boring Station to give them an update on the project.

2. MADRONE WALL PARK UPDATE

Madrone Wall is no longer known as Hardscrabble Quarry but rather Madrone Wall Park. Progress at Madrone Wall Park is on hold because of some visitors; peregrine falcons. The falcons are endangered birds and people are not permitted near the nesting site. There are no trespassing signs posted at the park. These birds could be dangerous if people were too close as they are known to be protectors. Mike McLees has notified law enforcement who patrols the area that if anyone is caught trespassing they are to be ticketed and fined. Two North Clackamas Parks employees spotted this family of 4 birds during an outing. We are hoping the birds leave by the end of June but could come back year after year as they typically find one spot and stay until they fledge.

3. METRO PROPERTY ACQUISITION GRANT

Metro has purchased property adjacent to Barton Park. We are in negotiations with Metro regarding maintenance and our share of the property purchase.

4. CAMAVA RESERVATIONS UPDATE

Sandy Weijland gave an overview of the new reservation software we are in the process of acquiring. At this point parks staff is in contact with Greg Hechler from CAMAVA and we have uploaded park photos and are in the process of entering specific park information in to a spreadsheet. We hope to have the software up and running by the middle of August.

5. TOURING OF THE PARKS

Staff will put together an itinerary of parks of interest for a tour in August.

6. RETIREMENT CELEBRATIONS

June Routson and Dan Zinzer are retiring after many years of service to county parks. We celebrated with cake and ice cream and June received a gift from the parks staff. Both June and Dan put in many long, hard years and will be missed by all.
