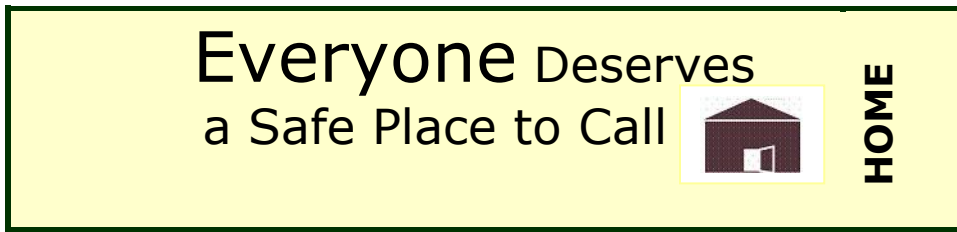


In Clackamas County



Student Homelessness Continues to Grow in Clackamas School District

20,545 students, in grades K-12 statewide, were identified as homeless in school year 2010-2011

That's a 7.9 percent increase from the previous school year.

Clackamas County School Districts - Many Students in School But Not Homes

As reported by School District Homeless Liaisons the number of homeless students served in Clackamas County school in 2010 -2011 was 1542. This number represents a

20.4% increase over last year (Note: Clackamas exceeded the 7.9 % increase of the state)
97.4% increase since school year 2006-2007

Of the 1542 Clackamas homeless students served in the 2010-2011 school year:

- 319 - were homeless students are unaccompanied youth
- 85 - lived in shelters
- 1326 - lived in doubled up situations
- 179 - were unsheltered
- 73 - lived in motels

Note: - School year 2010 - 2011 was the first time data was widely available on the number of homeless preschoolers in Oregon. With the assistance of Head Start and Oregon Pre-Kindergarten Programs, homeless preschoolers (age 3-5) were identified. This number is not included in this K-12 total.
