The mission of the Clackamas Resource Connection is to provide consumers with expert planning for long term aging or disability care before a crisis develops. The Clackamas Resource Connection always seeks to maintain the independence and self-determination of those looking for help.

The Clackamas Resource Connection targets its services to seniors and people with disabilities who are not on Medicaid, but may still have trouble affording long term care and assistance. However, the Clackamas Resource Connection will serve anyone who requests assistance, regardless of need or Medicaid eligibility status.

- CRC assistance is intended for seniors and people with disabilities that anticipate needing long term care
- CRC offers services to everyone, regardless of income
- CRC is targeted to people that are not eligible for Medicaid
