### Entry Fees:

\$10.00 per Public Competition Exhibitor or \$5.00 per 4-H/FFA crossover exhibitor. What does this mean? Instead of charging exhibitors a pen fee, we decided to go with a flat \$10 fee for Public Competition or \$5 if you're a 4-H/FFA exhibitor per show, regardless of how many animals you exhibit.

Class Fees: \$8.00 per head

Entry form and fees are due in the fair office by **June 30, 2017**. You can bring your form and fees to the Fair Office directly or mail them. Make checks payable to CCEC. The Fair address is 694 SE 4<sup>th</sup> Ave. Canby, OR 97013

Due to limited pen space, entries will be closed when pens are full.

### Rotations:

1. The Boer Goat show is held during the second rotation during the fair. All entries must be in the barn by **9:45 AM** Thursday August 17, 2017. No tack or setup is allowed before this time, (per Overall Livestock Superintendent). Animals will be released in the morning of Sunday August 20, 2017.

### Specific Rules:

1. Exhibitors should read General Rules and Regulations and Livestock Department Rules found on Clackamas County Fair website under Exhibitor Handbook.
2. Bedding must be furnished by the exhibitor.
3. Pens must be cleaned every day prior to 8:30 AM.
4. **No animals allowed in the barn until passing health check with the Superintendent. Please refer to the Livestock Department Rules and Regulations, especially if you are bringing animals from Out of State.**
5. **Tack space is limited for all Open Livestock. Maximum space for Boer Goats is 2 goats per pen.**
6. **Only one days feeding is allowed in the barn. Exhibitors will be provided a drive in pass to use each morning to haul in more feed. All vehicles have to be off the grounds by 9:45 AM each morning.**
7. **All animals entered in the show must be registered with ABGA or USBGA registries. Original registration certificates must be presented at check-in for animals over 3**

months of age. Stamped copies of applications under 3 months of age will be accepted.

8. This is an unsanctioned show, the judge's placings are final.
9. Owners are responsible for ensuring their animals have legible tattoos; the judge will be the final determinant and reserves the right to dismiss any animal for lack of a legible tattoo. Microchips are not acceptable forms of identification.
10. Pens will be assigned. Mark number of pens required on entry form. (Only 2 goats allowed per pen.)

1 Exhibitor in each lot: 1<sup>st</sup> = \$11.00 2<sup>nd</sup> = \$8.50

2 or more Exhibitors in each lot: 1<sup>st</sup> = 14.00 2<sup>nd</sup> \$11.00 3<sup>rd</sup> = \$8.50 4<sup>th</sup> = \$6.00 5<sup>th</sup>=\$4.00 6<sup>th</sup>=\$2.00

Premium money must be picked up at the fair office.
