Entry Fees:

1. Dairy Goat Herd Fee: \$10.00 per Public Competition Exhibitor or \$5.00 per 4-H/FFA Crossover Exhibitors
2. (This is in addition to the new Fair Exhibitor Fee of \$10.00.)
3. Entry Fee: \$5.00 per head.

Entry form and fees are due in the fair office by **June 30, 2016.**

Rotations:

The Dairy Goat show is held during the first rotation during the fair. Dairy Goats must be in the barn by 9:00 PM Monday August 14, 2017 and will be released Wednesday August 16, 2017 (per Overall Livestock Superintendent). Animals must be removed by 8:30 PM. (Arrival on Sunday afternoon/evening, August 13, 2017 must be OK'd by Livestock or Open Dairy Goat Superintendent before the 12th.)

Specific Rules:

1. Exhibitors should read General Rules and Regulations and Livestock Department Rules found on Clackamas County Fair website under Exhibitor Handbook.
2. The exhibitor must furnish bedding. Straw allowed for milking does.
3. **No animals allowed in the barn until passing health check with the Superintendent.**
4. **Tack space is limited for all Open Livestock. Tack pens assigned as available.**
5. Only one days feeding is allowed in the barn. Exhibitors will be provided a drive in pass to use each morning to haul in more feed. All vehicles have to be off the grounds by 9:45 AM each morning.
6. Pens will be assigned. Mark number of pens requested on entry form.
7. **ELY BARN:** Decoration rule- top of curtains/banners needs to be 8' off the ground and a maximum of 24" long. No obstruction between bottom of curtain and ground level. No lattice allowed as curtains or back drops.
8. All dairy goats six months of age and older must have a registration or recordation certificate and appropriate tattoo marks. Any dairy goats under six months of age must have a registration or recordation certificate; or the stamped duplicate applications showing the date received by the American Dairy Goat Association office.
9. The American Dairy Goat Association recognizes this show as an **Official Show** and A.D.G.A. rules shall govern. The Junior and Senior shows are not separately sanctioned.
10. Attire: White shirt, long white or black pants. **No Blue Jeans.**
11. The base date for computing the age of the animal shall be the day the animal is judged.

Show Schedule: *The show order on Tuesday is subject to change, depending on the entries received in each breed or by judges request. If different than what is published here, you will be notified. Please note that last year Alpines were moved out of AOP and Nubians were moved in. The yearly decision is made based on numbers from the year before.*

5. Milking Doe, under 2 years.
6. Milking Doe, 2 years and under 3 years.
7. Milking Doe, 3 years and under 5 years.
8. Milking Doe, 5 years and under 7 years.
9. Milking Doe, 7 years and older.
Senior Champion, Ribbon Only
Reserve Senior Champion, Ribbon Only
Grand Champion, Rosette Only
Reserve Grand Champion, Rosette Only
10. Champion Challenge, permanent champions and the Grand Champion of the day.
11. Get-Of-Sire, 3 does any age with same sire, name sire, limited to two entries per exhibitor.

12. Produce of Dam, 2 does any age with same dam, name dam, limited to 2 entries per exhibitor.
13. Breeder's Dairy Herd, 3 does in milk, owned and bred by exhibitor. Winner eligible to compete for Supreme Herd Award; limited to 2 entries per exhibitor.
Best Doe of Show, all breeds compete, Trophy.

Special Awards:

NW Oregon Dairy Goat Association will present \$5.00 to the owner of the Grand Champion Doe of each breed.
