Rotations:

1. The Pygmy Goat show is held during the second rotation during the fair. All entries must be in the barn by **9:45 AM Friday August 17, 2018**. Entries will be released Sunday August 20. Details on move out TBA at a later date.

Specific Rules:

1. Exhibitors should read General Rules and Regulations and Livestock Department Rules found on Clackamas County Fair website under Exhibitor Handbook.
2. Bedding must be furnished by the exhibitor. **No Cedar.**
3. Pens must be cleaned every day prior to 8:30 AM.
4. Pens will be assigned. **Mark number of pens required on entry form.**
5. **No animals allowed in the barn until passing health check with the Superintendent.**
6. **Tack space is limited for all Open Livestock.** Combined tack areas may be necessary due to space limitations.
7. **ELY BARN:** Decoration rule- top of curtains/banners needs to be 8' off the ground and a maximum of 24" long. No obstruction between bottom of curtain and ground level. No lattice allowed as curtains or back drops. The only lattice allowed is one 4' wide by 6' tall sheet per club on the north or south end of the pen row. Changes may be necessary during fair due to air flow and air quality for animal & human health.
8. **Only one days feeding is allowed in the barn. Exhibitors will be provided a drive in pass to use each morning to haul in more feed. All vehicles have to be off the grounds by 9:45 AM each morning.**
9. **Check-in with superintendent is Friday August 17th from 10:00AM to Noon, or 7:30 AM to 8:30AM prior to the start of the show Saturday, August 18th ONLY. All exhibitors must check in with the Superintendent prior to the start of the show. If another check**

in time is necessary, please make arrangements with Superintendent in advance of Saturdays show.

10. Registration papers are required for all registered animals. These papers need to be provided to the superintendent during check in.
11. Classes 2 through 4 will be sanctioned by National Pygmy Goat Association. NPGA rules shall govern and take precedence over all others.
12. Unregistered wethers may be shown in the sanctioned wether classes as long as wethers appear to the judge to be purebred pygmy goats. If there are no registration certificates and the unregistered wether wins, they will receive the rosette, but not be able to accept the win through NPGA.
13. All Animals entered in group classes must be shown in individual classes.
14. We are offering showmanship and encourage all to participate. No entry fee. No premiums paid, however participation prizes will be awarded.

 - Best Wether, Ribbon Only
 - Reserve Best Wether, Ribbon Only
