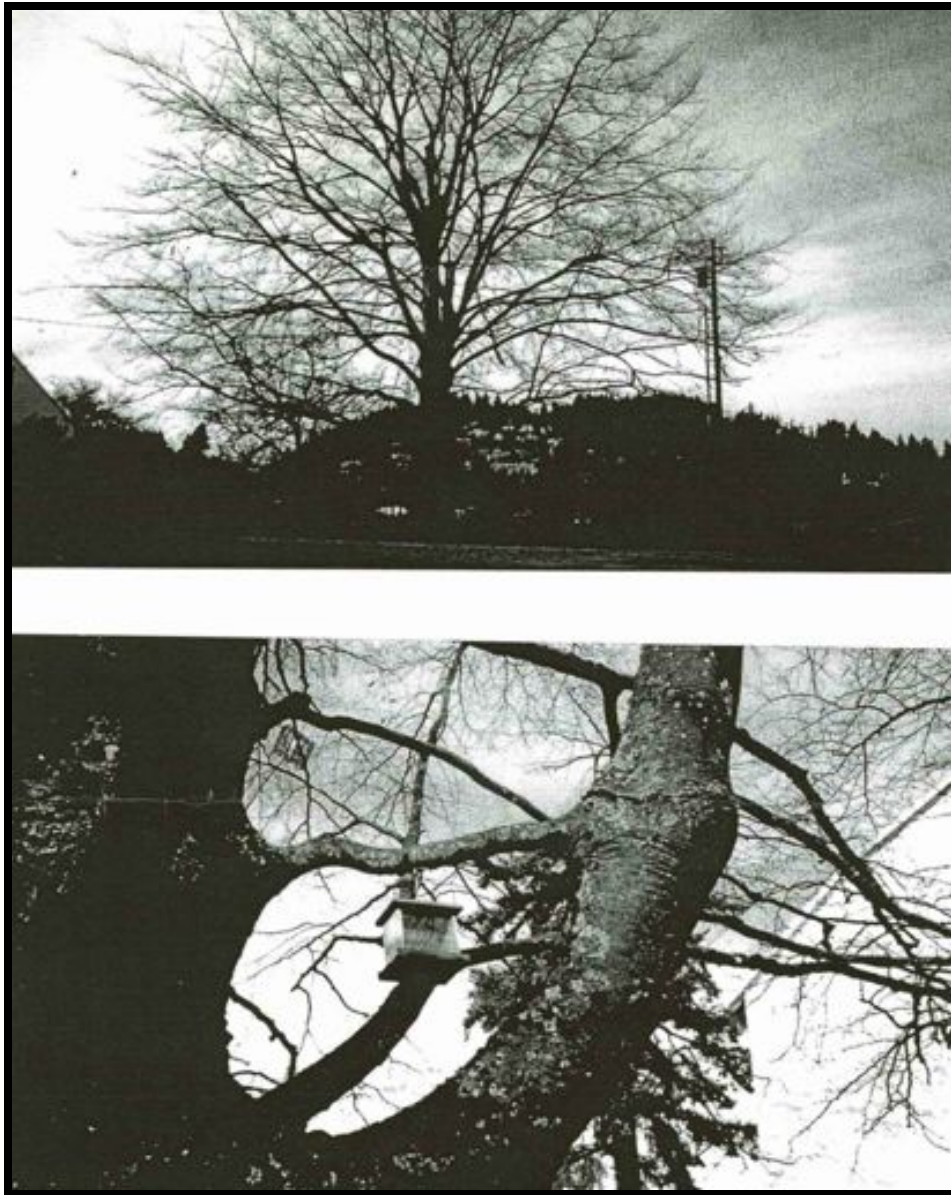


# Clackamas County Heritage Tree

Luscher Farm Copper Beech (*Fagus cuprea*)

**Location:** 125 Rosemont Road, Luscher Farm  
**Owner:** City of Lake Oswego, Oregon



🌲 **Significance:** *Specimen:* trees of exceptional size, *Historical Association*

🌲 **Measurements (approximate):**

- Height: **60'**
- Circumference (meas. at 4 ½'): **12' 6"**
- Crown Spread: **32'**
- Age: **90 - 100 years**

🌲 **Dedication Ceremony:** May 1, 2008

**Additional Information:** This tree is a very interesting graft supporting a very large lower branch. This supporting graft goes from the main trunk to rejoin with the tree's large lower branch. It is assumed that the Copper beech tree was planted in the back yard of the farm house shortly after it was built in 1900.
