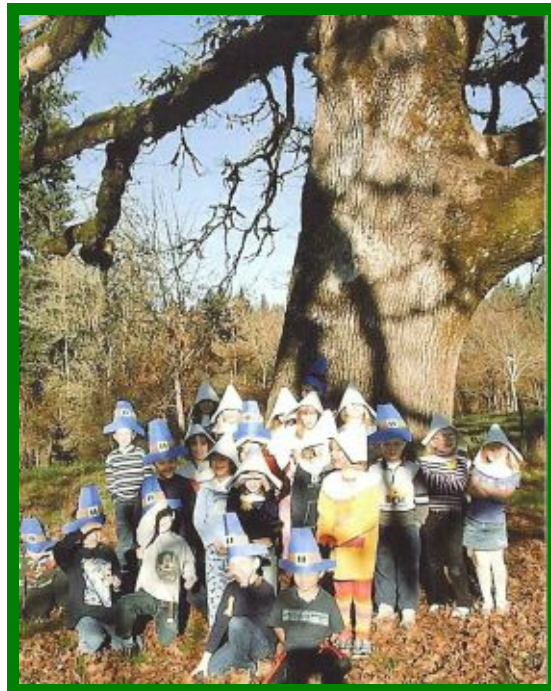



Clackamas County Heritage Tree

Stand of two Oregon White Oak (*Quercus garryana*)

 **Location:** 30391 SE Hwy 211, Eagle Creek




 **Significance:** *Specimen:* trees of exceptional size and age, *Collection*

 **Measurements** (approximate):

- Height: 80' – 100'
- Circumference (meas. at 4 ½'): 9', 14'
- Crown Spread: 120' – 140'
- Age: 350 +years

 **Dedication Ceremony:** May 1, 2008

 **Additional Information:** “These two incredible trees grace the back field of Eagle Creek Elementary School. They have shaded generations of students, been a part of Dragon Day Swings and inspired numerous botanists. They are located across the road from the Historic Philip Foster Farm.”
