

Clackamas County Heritage Tree

Sequoia giganteum / Sierra redwood
(Sequoiadendron giganteum)

📍 **Location:** 990 SW Long Farm Rd., West Linn, OR







🌲 **Significance:** *Specimen:* a tree of exceptional size, form or rarity and *Historic Association*

🌲 **Measurements** (approximate):

- Height: **130+**
- Circumference (meas. at 4 ½’): **34’ 9”**

🌲 **Additional Information:** This very large tree is located on the J. George & Mary Nagl Farm, c.1900, Clackamas County Historic Landmark. It is prominent on the landscape with branches sweeping to the ground. The tree has lived adjacent to an underground cistern of water until the cistern was drained in about 1995. The location of the cistern adjacent to the tree may account for the excellent growing conditions leading to the large size.

The State Champion Giant sequoia is located in Washington County. It’s circumference measures 392 “. This tree measures 417 “ making it perhaps eligible to challenge the existing State Champ.
