County Memorial Tree Site—Various Species

In 2005 the Board of County Commissioners approved a master plan on the Red Soils property, the central campus of Clackamas County, to include an employee memorial site. The master plan supports the planting of trees to commemorate employees that have died while actively employed. This began in 2004 when the first building in the Master Plan was opened and dedicated.

A variety of 20 trees are on the site and are planned for future plantings including the following species: Cedar, Oregon White Oak, Maple, Dogwood, Redwood, Spruce and Douglas Fir.

This grove of trees qualifies under the Heritage Tree landmark category.
