### Coast Redwood

Coast Redwoods are naturally found along the narrow coast strip from Big Sur Coast in California to southwestern Oregon.

A typical specimen will grow from seed 100 feet in 50 years with an average diameter of 20 feet. They can live more than 2,000 years. The tallest living specimen is 379.1 feet in height. Many are more than 320 feet in height.

This tree has a dominate presence in the community and towers over most of the growth in the area.

This tree is nominated and approved under the Heritage Tree category of specimen.
