




Age-Friendliness: Why and How?






Age-Friendliness: Urban and Rural

How to Use the Polling Units



- The polling units work like a remote control or telephone key pad

How to Use the Polling Units


To vote, press the button that corresponds to the number (#) of your selection







Where do you live?









Physical Environment




Clackamas County has a physical environment that is planned and built for livability and supports physical and mental health behaviors and quality of life for all ages.



Outdoor spaces and building design in Clackamas County support community livability, accommodate mobility and independence, and foster social interaction and inclusion.



Social Environment


Older persons want to do more than simply continue to reside in their communities—they want to be able to contribute to, and benefit from, and feel included in community life.





Clackamas County is a health-promoting community environment that supports active involvement, social and cultural participation, and intergenerational connectivity among all residents.



All people living in Clackamas County have access to social networks, social participation and feel socially connected, respected, and included in community life.




Keeping people informed and feeling supported about broader community information and services allows older adults to be better connected to their community and supports them in their daily activities.



In Clackamas County, community supports and services, including health services, that meet the varying needs and abilities of older residents are available and accessible to all residents.





- Community Support & Health Services (31%)**






