We can assure you the roads are safe to travel while they are open. If they become unsafe they will be closed.

This landslide is part of a larger, ancient slide in the area called the Spangler Slide, which has the potential to continue to impact the area. The Oregon Department of Geology and Mineral Industries (DOGAMI) has informed us that this is a deep slide that may impact roadways and your private property.

We are informing you about this so that you can be aware of the risk and choose to explore this issue further by hiring a geotechnical engineer or comparable expert to investigate the status of your property. This will help you make an educated decision about what may need to be done to protect your property. As a government agency, we do not have the authority to provide specific services related to this on private property.
